## The process

- ☐ The process started in June 2014: Where ToR were prepared and submitted to the Consultant (Economic and Social Research Tanzania ESRF)
- ☐ Technical Review Panel (TRP) & Mult-Sectoral Task Force (MTF) which involved different stakeholders were established.
  - ☐ Their main task was to review and provide comments for the draft Policy from the Consultant. (Internal review)
- ☐ The task force(Core-Team) was established which was made up with members from VPO & NEMC with the main task of coordination (Secretariat)

## The process cont.....

☐ First layer of Consultations: Five zonal meetings were conducted to obtain stakeholders comment from all Regions in Tanzania

- ☐ Second layer of consultations: Involved:
  - ☐ MDAs –Different institutions; Research and Academic Institutions; Private Sector; Non Governmental Organizations; VPO Mngmt, VPO staff

### The process cont....

- ☐ After consultations:
  - ☐ Synthesis/analysis of all comments from a wide range of stakeholders consultated in the process
  - ☐ Incorporation into the Draft Policy of substantive comments from stakeholders to produce the Final Draft Policy
  - Process of the Final Draft (already comments from the Cabinet Secretariat have been attained to finalize the Policy)

## The Approach

- ☐ Sectoral Approach Vs Issues (NEP 1997)
  - ☐ Clarity on directives
  - ☐ Policy directives to specific sector

#### Design of the draft Policy:

The draft Policy has five chapters

- ☐ Chapter 1 Introduction
  - Overview on NEP 1997
  - ❖ Situational Analysis (Focus: NEP 1997 six Env. Challenges)
- ☐ Chapter 2: The aim of Policy review
  - Policy review justification
  - Vision & Mission
  - Objectives (Overall and Specific)
- ☐ Chapter 3: Policy statements
  - Issue(s)
  - Objective
  - Policy Statement(s)



#### Chapter 3 cont....

- ☐ The Chapter divide into 3 parts:
  - ❖ Sectoral policy issues: e.g. Agric (crop farming), Livestock, Health, Fisheries, Forest, Energy, Transport, etc
  - Thematic Policy issues: e.g. Land; Environmental quality & Health; Climate change; Forestry, Oil and Gas, Biodiversity, Disasters & Crises etc
  - Cross-cutting Policy issues: e.g. Gender, HIV & AIDS, Good Governance etc.

#### Design cont....

- ☐ Chapter **4:** Legal framework:
  - Legal Framework: Highlights what will happen to legal Framework in light of the Revised Policy

- ☐ Chapter **5:** Institutional framework:
  - Institutional framework: Highlighting roles & responsibilities of key players
  - Monitoring & Evaluation: VPO playing key roles in coordination, implementation and M & E of the revised Policy

## **Env. Quality Vs Human Health**

- ☐ Environmental quality & health (sect. 3.2.2)
  - Intrinsically interrelated
  - Has a bearing on the costs of environmentally related health risks
  - Investing in a healthy environment is investing in the health and well-being of our current and future generations
  - Addressing the links btn Env quality & health will b key to achieving the 2030 Agenda on SD and the SDGs

## **Env. Quality cont...**

- ☐ The Revised Policy in this regard provide directives that will protect our people from being exposed to environmental related risks leading to an array of health disorders from:
  - Poor air quality
  - Radiations
  - Chemicals
  - Wastes (toxic)
  - Noise pollution
  - Poor water quality
